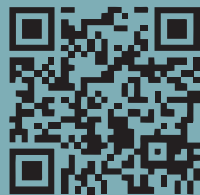

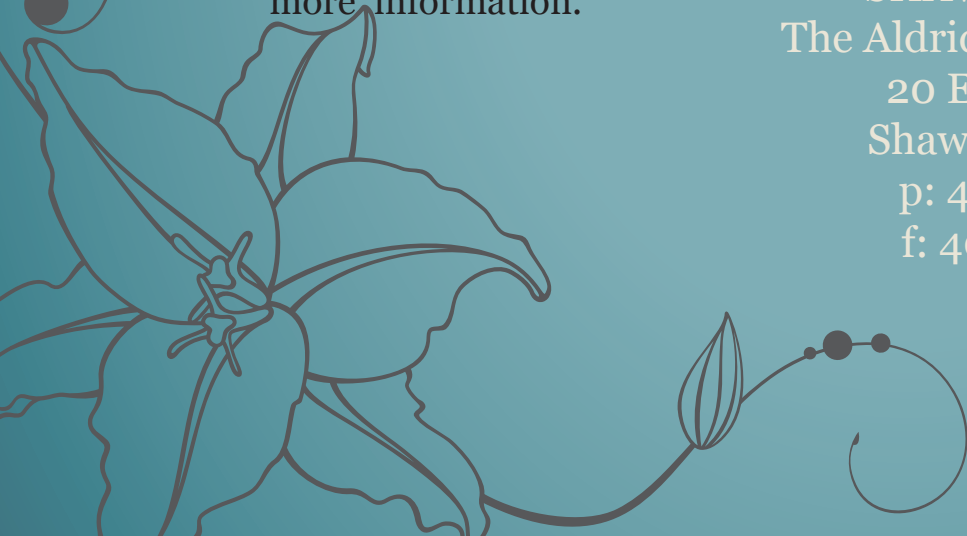

We address the emotional and spiritual needs of the patient and family. Social workers, chaplains and trained volunteer staff provide a plan of care that is flexible as patient and family needs change.

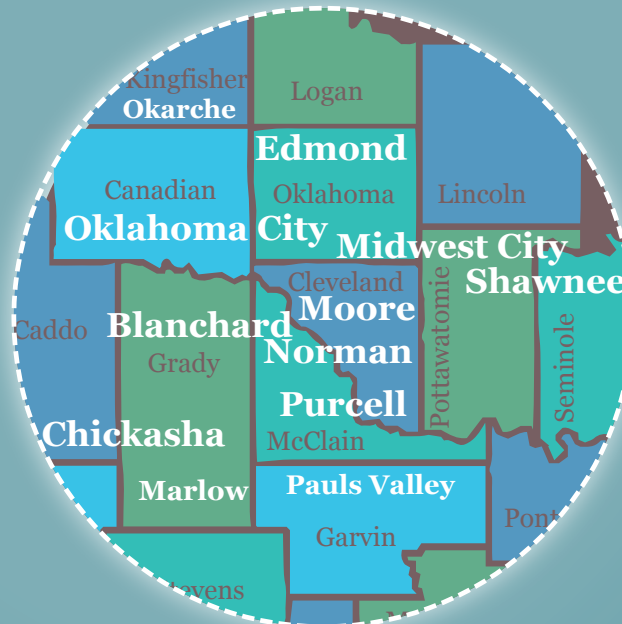
Hospice Where You Are

Medicare pays 100% for Hospice Care, and many insurance plans have a hospice benefit. There is usually no cost to the patient and/or family for hospice services.

Our Angel Team
